I am contacting you on behalf of the <u>Therapists for Armenia</u> and <u>Armenian American Sports Medicine</u> <u>Coalition</u> organizations - a collective body of international clinicians who strive to advance the rehabilitation field in Armenia through educational outreach, collaboration, and advocacy. I write to you today to explore your interest in sponsoring a virtual conference that will help develop Armenian rehabilitation services in response to the current humanitarian crisis.

The 2020 Nagorno-Karabakh War has strained Armenia's health system with the management of thousands of wounded soldiers and refugees in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic. Since the start of the war in September 2020, our organizations have initiated various efforts including coordination of rehabilitation volunteers traveling to Armenia, donation of therapeutic supplies, clinical webinars related to treatment and assessment of war injuries, teleconsultation with in-country clinicians, and a digital resource library.

In order to further advance the field and promote international collaboration, we are organizing the *Post-Conflict Rehabilitation Virtual Symposium* to be held on July 17th & 18th, 2021. The goals of the conference are as follows:

- To stimulate interdisciplinary collaboration among Armenian healthcare providers to address identified challenges related to post-war rehabilitation.
- Facilitate the connection of Armenian healthcare providers and international rehabilitation experts to share evidence-based treatment methodologies and build local capacity.
- Empower local rehabilitation professionals to share their expertise and experience in an international platform, bringing awareness to the unique challenges of post-war Armenia.
